Parent Center Exchange Program

Designed to promote center interconnectivity and hands-on learning. One center will serve as the host center and the other center will send some of its staff to visit. During the visit, centers will share information, strategies and materials.

Site Visits

In person visits from a Region 4 staff person or selected consultant to your center that is customized to meet your center's specific needs. Visits may include: Board training; strategic planning; staff development; team building; review of agency policies and procedures; crisis management support; etc.

Region 4 Annual Conference

Nonprofit Management Certificate Program

Each year, a genre of nonprofit management will be explored using in-person and technology based learning opportunities. Participants who complete that year's training requirements will earn a "mini-certificate" in the competency area. Program is co-sponsored by a four year university.

ICAP

Individual Center Assistance Plan to provide additional support to help your center develop or maintain capacity in a self-identified area of improvement.

One-to-One Assistance

Available to all centers anytime via phone or email. Includes support on: crisis management; board issues; grant implementation and reporting/evaluation; financial issues; some legal and information technology issues; policy and procedure questions; human resources issues; grantwriting and fundraising; etc. Also connect Region 4 centers with OSEP-funded TA&D Network.

Multicultural Consultation

Receive support on multicultural issues related to serving Latino and/or Native American populations by experienced, bi-lingual Region 4 staff.

Teleconferences & Webinars

Teleconferences and/or webinars will be offered that address a variety of non-profit and parent center issues. Issues will be identified using input and preferences from Region 4 parent centers.
